Academically advanced juniors and seniors are encouraged to participate in dual-enrollment with an accredited college. Interested students will apply to the college directly.

What colleges offer Dual-Enrollment?



Carlisle Christian Academy will provide necessary transcripts and signatures. The family is responsible for college related fees, most of which are greatly reduced for qualifying high school students (as low as \$100 per credit). SAT scores, entrance testing, and GPA are commonly used to assess student readiness for these programs.

Guidelines Continued

PROGRAMS FOR QUALIFYING SENIORS:

Academic Scholars (up to 2 courses per semester)

- 3.5+GPA can take 2 college courses per semester.
- Early release or late arrival are options.
- One study hall per course, wifi access, and a laptop at CCA for college coursework.
- 3+ courses will be taken at CCA each semester.
- Christian Worldview Advisor is assigned (See Junior requirement)
- Behavior and academic issues affect eligibility
- \$400 credit to family per college course.
- College transcripts are given to CCA within 1 week of posting and courses are recorded as Honors on CCA transcript.

Early Start (3+ college courses per semester, no daily attendance at CCA)

- *Eligibility requirements:*
- *GPA of 3.5 or above*
- B or above in a junior year dual enrollment course
- A minimum of 22 completed high school credits
- Ability to meet all core requirements with college credits by Dec. of graduation year.
- Acceptance into a college program allowing 9+ credits per semester.
- Student fulfills all remaining required HS credits at a college and carries a minimum of 9 credits per semester.
- Christian Worldview Advisor is assigned (See Junior requirement)
- Approved project for CCA Open House.
- Attends graduation, student is eligible for academic and athletic related awards.
- College transcripts are given to CCA within 1 week of posting and courses are recorded as Honors on CCA transcript.
- Behavior and academic issues affect eligibility.
- May participate in CCA trips, parties, & athletics.
- \$1000 tuition plus CCA registration for the year.





Grades for dual–enrollment courses fulfill PA graduation requirements. Here is what you do:

- Tell CCA of your interest in DE.
- 2. Apply to the College's DE program (links are on the CCA Website under Academics).
- Complete testing and orientation if required by the college.
- 4. Email college report card to CCA.
- Send both CCA and college transcripts when applying to schools.



What is the pathway to Dual Enrollment?



Academic Scholars Program (12th grade)

- Up to 2 courses/ sem.
- Early release/late arrival when college courses conflict
- Spring Open House Project
- \$400 tuition credit per course when 2 are taken in one semester
- Time at CCA to work on College (optional)

Early College Start (12th grade)

- 3+ courses/sem.
- No daily attendance at CCA
- Spring Open House Project
- Graduate with CCA and eligible for awards
- CCA maintains HS records
- Adjusted CCA tuition
- All required courses must fit in fall semester

Guidelines:

Freshman and Sophomores

• Take a minimum of 7 credits per year with a GPA of 3.5 or above (3.0 for Senior year dualenrollment)

Juniors

- Students with a 3.5 or above in 9th and 10th grade are eligible for 1 DE course per semester.
- No early release/late arrival.
- A minimum of 5 courses (one less than typical students) must be taken at CCA
- One study hall, wifi access, and a laptop at CCA for college coursework.
- When a college course is taught from a secular perspective, an academic advisor is assigned to meet with the student to discuss how a Christian world view affects the topic of study. The student is responsible for keeping a weekly journal of questions for discussion.
- An A or B in the junior year DE course(s) and a minimum of 22 high school graduation credits is required to be eligible for Early Start Program in senior year.
- Behavior and academic issues can affect eligibility for dual enrollment.
- Exceptions to the guidelines must have approval of the administration.
- College transcripts are given to CCA within 1 week of posting and courses are recorded as Honors on CCA transcript.

Seniors participating in first Dual Enrollment

• Same as Juniors, but the GPA is 3.0+
