Kindergarten Supply List 2026-27

Please do not give your child a personal pencil sharpener for school.

Backpack

Lunchbox

Refillable SPILL PROOF water bottle (no glass) that your child can operate easily. Please teach them to re-close it after every use.

1 – Pair of blunt tip child's scissors

1 – Eraser

20 – Pencils #2 for classroom use

1 – Bottle of craft glue for classroom use (not regular runny classroom glue please) the Elmer's screw top craft glue is better than the pop off tiny lid Aileen's craft glue has.

1 – Large pack of glue sticks for classroom use

2 – Sets of crayons 24 pack (please put your child's name on each box)

2 – Sets colored pencils (please put your child's name on each box)

2 – Sets of markers (please put your child's name on each box)

4 – Inexpensive basic plastic boxes to keep supplies organized in the desk (one for crayons, one for markers, one for pencils, one for scissors, glue stick, etc). Please put your child's name on each case.

2 – Containers of antibacterial like Clorox wipes (to clean desks daily – teacher use only)

2 – Package of unscented baby wipes (for cleaning hands and faces when necessary)

2 – Boxes of tissues

2 – Rolls of paper towels

1 – Pair of wired headphones please put your child's name on them

1 – Nap mat, throw blanket, or beach towel to lay on at rest time

1 – Clear plastic pencil box (approx. 8" x 5" x 2" - does not need to be exact, just close)
(Bible class storytelling box)

Full set of spare clothing including: underwear, socks, and shoes (in case of accidents) in a large zip lock bag with your child's name on it.

Kids may bring one small stuffed toy for rest time. It must fit in the backpack and be carried and kept in the backpack until they unpack in the classroom. Please put their name on the tag. Please do not allow other toys to come to school.

Tip: One of my students' parents taped or glue gunned family pictures to the inside of the lids of her plastic supply containers. This was a great comfort to that child when she missed mom and dad that first week.
